



PLEASE NOTE: **You will lose root but can easily get it back again!!!**

Requirements:

Item needed	Notes
RSD Lite and Drivers	RSD Lite is a firmware-flashing application by Motorola. (RSD stands for Remote Software Download.) More info here . This zip file includes both the RSD Lite application and the Motorola 32bit drivers.
Motorola 64 bit Drivers	Motorola End User Driver Installation for 64 bit systems
Final Release SBF	The 1FF-sunfire-user-2.3.4-4.5.1A-1_SUN-154-CM-Release-keys-signed-Sprint-US.sbf.gz update file

Steps:

1.	Download and Install RSD Lite & Driver package from link above.	
2.	Download the SBF file above and extract it to your PC/Laptop.	
3a.	On your phone, Power down your Phone.	
3b.	Hold Volume up and Power button	

3c.	You will see the "Starting RSD protocol support message	
4.	Launch RSD Lite from your program menu on your pc/laptop	 RSD Lite v5.3.1 Multi-Flash / Multi-Flex Tool
5.	Press the ". . ." button next to the box labeled "Filename"	
6.	Load the SBF file you extracted from the MR download.	
7.	Plug your device into your computer RSD Lite should recognize your phone right away if you installed the drivers from this link I provided	
8.	Press the Start button RSD Lite will then start updating the firmware. Be patient...It will take a while....and will reboot a couple of times so grab a beverage of choice... use the restroom, take out the dog, whatever.	
9.	You may require reactivation again... mine did so be sure you have a means in which to do so,...web...phone to call Sprint for programming, MSL code... OTA.
